

HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES

- 1** Health Risks: If you are sick, have a fever, present any signs of cold, flu, or COVID-19 symptoms, or if you have been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19 in the past 14 days, please stay home. In addition, if you are concerned about underlying health conditions or simply feel uncomfortable for any reason, feel free to stay home and worship with us online.
- 2** We have two services, at 9:00 am and at 10:30 am. Both services are MASK REQUIRED services. Masks are required for everyone over the age of 5 years old.
- 3** We encourage you to wear your own mask if you have one. We have masks available if you need one.
- 4** As you enter and exit the building, please use the provided hand sanitizer. We encourage warm smiles and waves, but we ask that you refrain from any physical contact. Please maintain 6-foot physical distancing between anyone of another household.
- 5** If you need to cough or sneeze, please cover your mouth and cough or sneeze into your elbow.
- 6** You may bring your own coffee from home as we will not be making and serving it onsite.
- 7** Parents, you are responsible for your children, so please keep them with you at all times. There will be no nursery, pre-school, or Children's Ministry until further notice.
- 8** The church doors will open at 8:30 am with both entrances available. We ask that you proceed directly to the worship center and take a seat in a section that reflects the size of your family. We have sections with 6 or 4 chairs per row as well as a few clusters of 8 for larger families. Ushers will be available to assist you in finding seats. Do not congregate in the lobby area.
- 9** The lobby restrooms will remain open for public use. The men's and women's restrooms are equipped with changing stations for families with small children.
- 10** A drop box for tithes and offerings is available upon entry and exit of the Worship Center. We would also encourage people to continue, or begin, using the online giving platform via our website.
